

Docket error notice: pro hac vice motion for a Cilia Flores attorney had to be refiled

What happened

The docket entry is labeled "FILING ERROR - DEFICIENT DOCKET ENTRY": a clerk notice that the filing had a formal defect and had to be refiled. The motion, signed by Mark E. Donnelly, asks for pro hac vice admission (permission for an out-of-state lawyer to appear in the case) to represent Cilia Adela Flores de Maduro. Donnelly states he is in good standing of the Texas bar and the bar of the Southern District of Texas, and that he attached an un-notarized affidavit.

What it means

This is a routine procedural step that does not change the charges or dates in the case.

What happens next

The document sets no new dates.

Key passages from the filing (verbatim)

"I am in good standing of the bar of the State of Texas and the bar of the Southern District of Texas"

Page 1 — The attorney states his bar standing in Texas.
