

Judge sets October 8 hearing on Cilia Flores's house-arrest request

What happened

According to the docket entry, Judge Alvin K. Hellerstein signed a memo endorsement (a short written order on a letter) setting a bond hearing for Cilia Flores on October 8, 2026 at 10:30 a.m. It also set deadlines: the government's response by September 23, 2026, and the defense reply by September 30, 2026.

What it means

Cilia Flores's lawyers asked that she be allowed to await trial under house arrest. With this order the judge will hear both sides at a hearing before deciding; the order does not rule on the request.

What happens next

The defense reply is due by September 30, 2026, and the hearing is set for October 8, 2026 at 10:30 a.m.
