

Cilia Flores pleads not guilty to three counts at arraignment

What happened

According to the docket entry, on January 5, 2026, Cilia Adela Flores de Maduro was arraigned before Judge Alvin K. Hellerstein on the S4 indictment and pleaded not guilty to counts 2, 3 and 4. The entry shows she remained detained and that the speedy-trial clock was excluded until March 17, 2026.

What it means

The not-guilty plea preserves the presumption of innocence as the case moves forward; the time exclusion is a routine step to allow discovery to be produced and reviewed.

What happens next

According to the entry, the next conference before the district judge was set for March 17, 2026 at 11:00 a.m.
